timeline

Singer, songwriter and recording artist Bill Price, a native of Indianapolis, performs both solo and with his band - performing for intimate house concerts or outdoor festivals alike. He has recorded CD's of both original and traditional music. His recordings have been played on radio stations around the United States and in Europe.

BIO: As a fan of The Beatles and Bob Dylan, Price set his sights on being a songwriter. “I don’t know if it was the realization that I was always going to be just an average guitar player, or the fact that I always have an opinion, that got me headed in the songwriting direction. But, for whatever reason, I just got that fire. I was inspired by certain music to try and do a similar thing, and I still am.”

In 2003 Price released his first album of original material, *Bones & Apples*. It received airplay in the U.S. and Europe on college and independent radio. He also teamed up with Indiana bluesman, Gordon Bonham to form The Brains Behind Pa, a three, sometimes five-piece band inspired by Dylan’s songs and influences. Their first effort was *Old Hat*, an EP CD that contained seven traditional, folk and blues songs. Their next album, *Better For The Deal*, released in 2006, has fifteen original songs and strongly reflects the band’s influences. Both albums received airplay on college and independent radio stations across the U.S., in Canada and Europe.

He has continued to perform and record music both with The Brains Behind Pa and other musicians. Price released *The Circus & The Gallows* 3-song CD single in 2007. In late 2009 he released *With the Eye of a Skeptic...*, an acoustic-based CD. The reception to this record has been the most positive and extensive that any of his albums have received so far with positive reviews and airplay across the U.S., in Canada and Europe.

2000 Forms The Brains Behind Pa trio with Gordon Bonham and Garry Bole.

2002 The Brains Behind Pa release *Old Hat* EP - an acoustic CD of traditional folk and blues songs. It receives airplay on various independent stations across the United States, in Canada and Europe.

2003 Releases *Bones & Apples* - a full-length CD of all original music. It receives airplay on independent stations.

2006 The Brains Behind Pa release *Better for the Deal* - a full-length CD of all original music. It receives strong reviews and airplay on independent stations across the United States, Europe and Scandinavia.

2007 Releases *The Circus & The Gallows* three-song CD single with a nine-piece band. It receives airplay on independent radio in Scandinavia and Europe.

2009 Releases *With the Eye of a Skeptic...* - a full-length CD of all original, acoustic music. It is currently receiving airplay on independent radio and warm reviews in Europe. The Brains Behind Pa film and record an acoustic concert at the historic Benton House in Irvington, Indiana.

2010 *With the Eye of a Skeptic...* album receives the most extensive coverage (press and airplay) of any of Price’s albums to date, getting attention and airplay in the U.K., Ireland, France, Germany, Sweden, Italy, Croatia, Belgium, The Netherlands and Australia. Two songs from The Brains Behind Pa Benton House concert are mixed, edited and posted on YouTube. *Blue Period Blues* is selected for a compilation album to benefit the Indiana Alzheimer’s Foundation.
